

## CHAPTER - 3

# The Economy of Saharsa District

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### 3.0 Introduction

Saharsa is one of the thirty-eight districts of Bihar. The area of Saharsa district is 1702 km<sup>2</sup>/657 sq miles and its population, according to 2001 census was 11, 32,413 as against 18,97,102 according to 2011 census. The density of population was 11, 25 per sq. km. according to the 2011 census.- Saharsa town is the administrative headquarters of this district. Saharsa district is a part of a larger territory, the Kosi Division and it became a district on 1 April 1954 and subsequently has become smaller with other districts being carved form it, most notably Madhepura in 1981.

Saharsa was created on first of april 1954. Formerly it had no independent status and parts of Saharsa were included in the old district of mongyr and Bhagalpur. A large parts of the district in the past was subjected to annual floods and inundation by a host of rivers origination from the Himalayas. The sub tarai was noted for rice cultivation before it was subjected to the vagaries of the unpredictable koshi. The district has been largely influenced

by its geography. Whatever humans of historically important sites that may have been virtually started by the repeated flooding at the koshi during the last half-century or so. With the efforts of some early Europeans however, some important historical objects or landmarks have been preserved in a few places and it is on the basis of these that some kind of a connected account of the early history of the district can be constructed.

### **3.1 Geography**

Saharsa district occupies an area of 1702 km<sup>2</sup>/657 sq miles comparatively equivalent to Russia's Bering Island. Saharsa district is surrounded on the west by the river Kosi, Koshi boasts an abundance of fish and makhana. Saharsa is famous for its varieties of Mango's and Summer Berry known as Litchi.

### **3.2. Economy**

In 2006 the Ministry of Panchayati Raj named Saharsa one of the country's 250 most backward districts (out of a total of 640). It is one of the 36 districts in Bihar currently receiving funds from the Backward Regions Grant Fund Programme (BRGF).

### **3.3. Demographical Profile**

Saharsa district comprises the two Sub-Divisions: Saharsa Sadar and Simri Bakhtiarpur. According to the 2011 census, Saharsa district has a population of 1,897,102, roughly equal to the nation of Lesotho or the US state of West Virginia. This gives it a ranking of 247th in India (out of 640). The district has a population density of 1,125 inhabitants per square kilometer (2,910/sq mi). Its population growth rate over the decade 2001–2011 was 25.79%. Saharsa has a sex ratio of 906 females for every 1000 males, and a literacy rate of 54.57%.

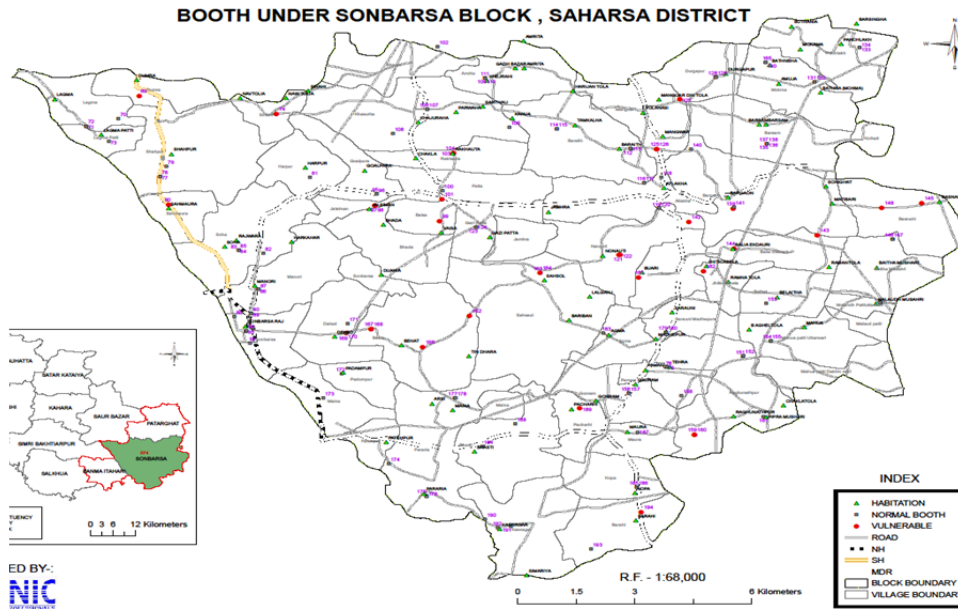

Sonbarsa Block Map of Saharsa District



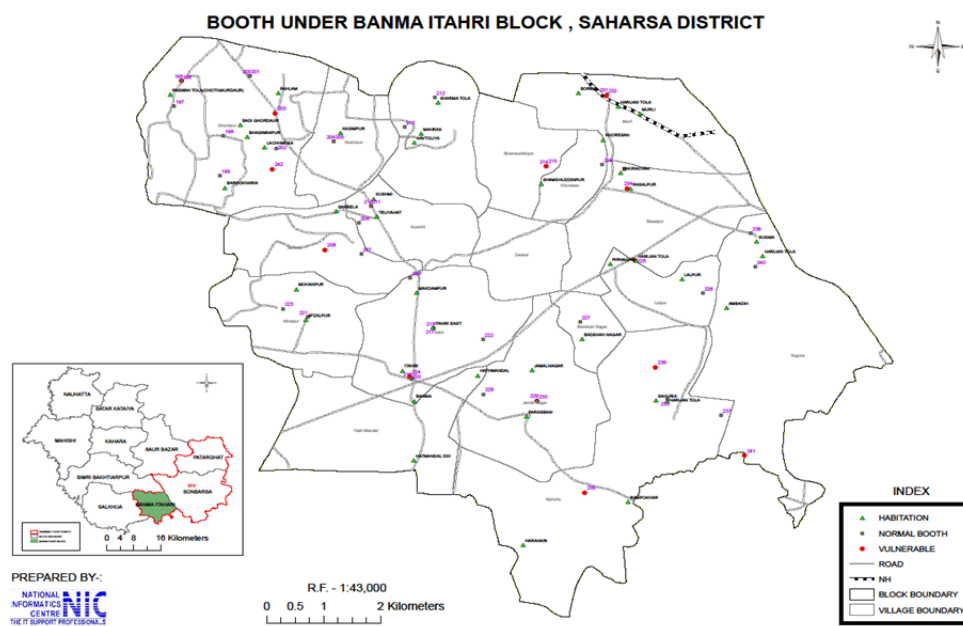

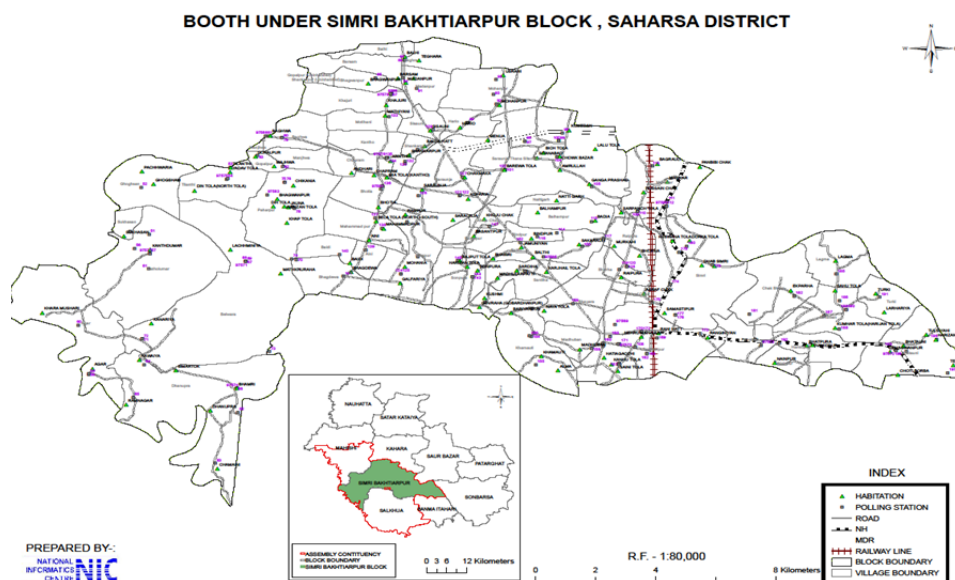

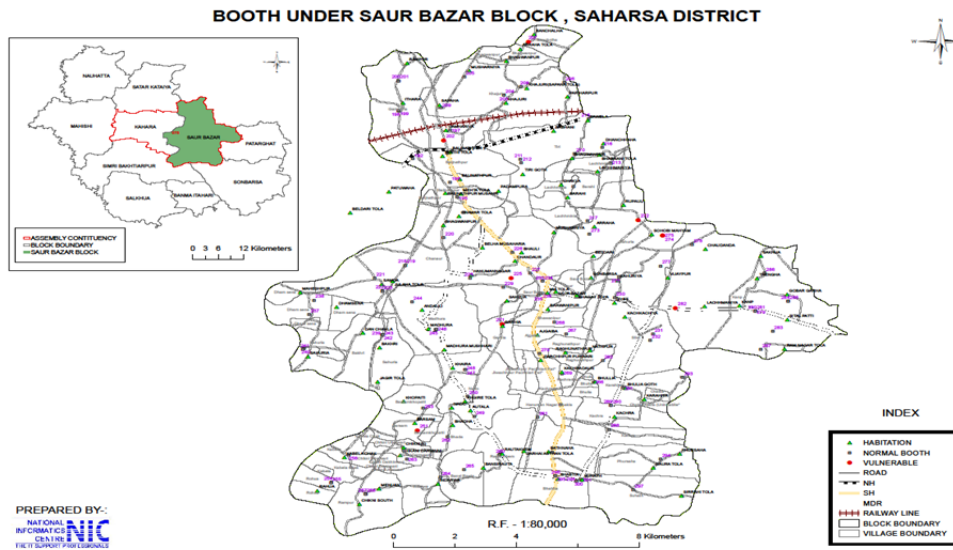
**Map: 3.5/Map of Simri Bakhtiarpur of Saharsa District**

### Map: 3.6/Map of Saur Bazar Block

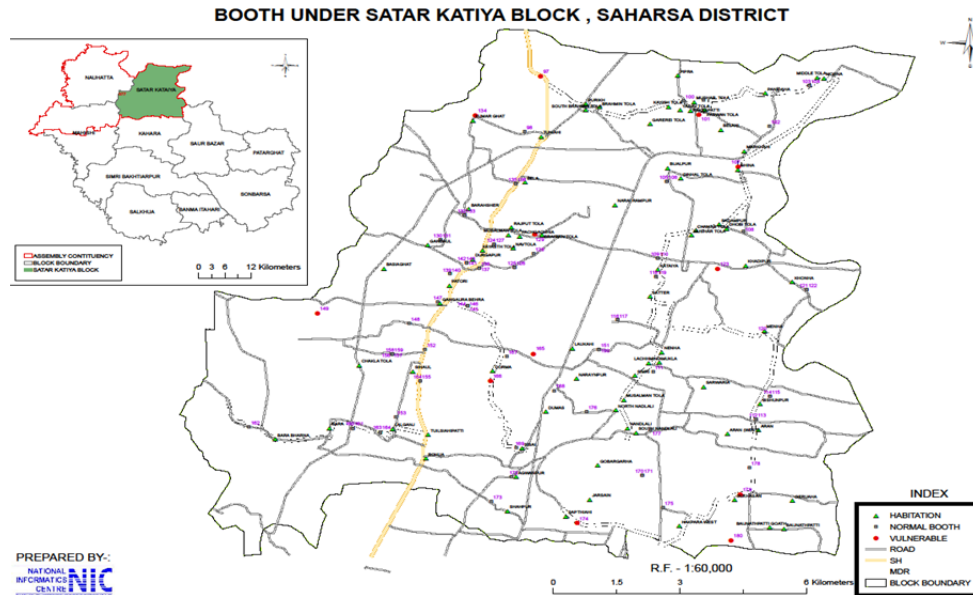

### Map: 3.7 /Showing Map of Sattar Kataiya Block



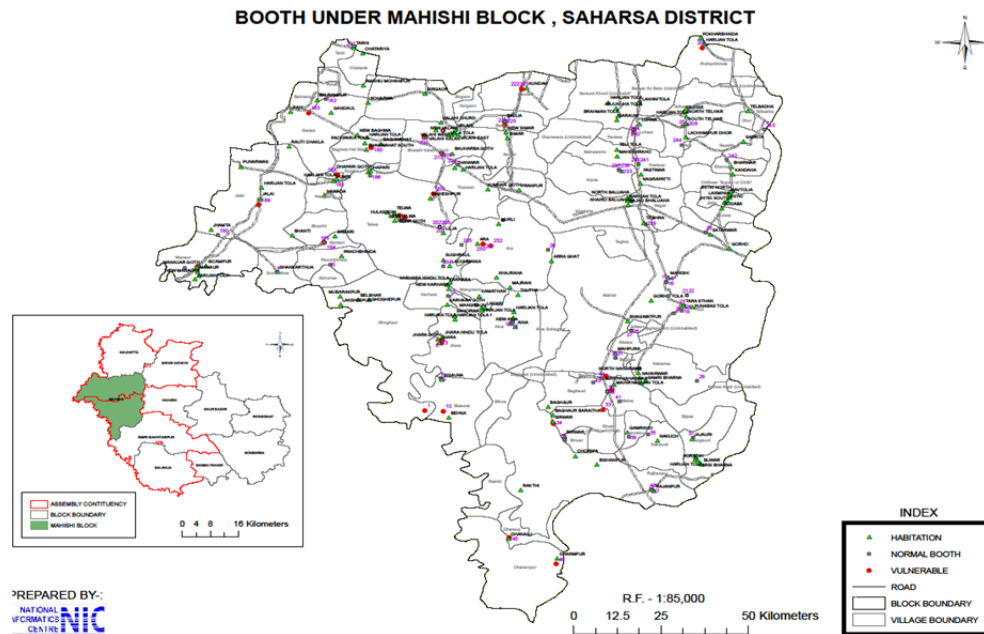

**Map:3.8 (Map of Mahishi Block)**



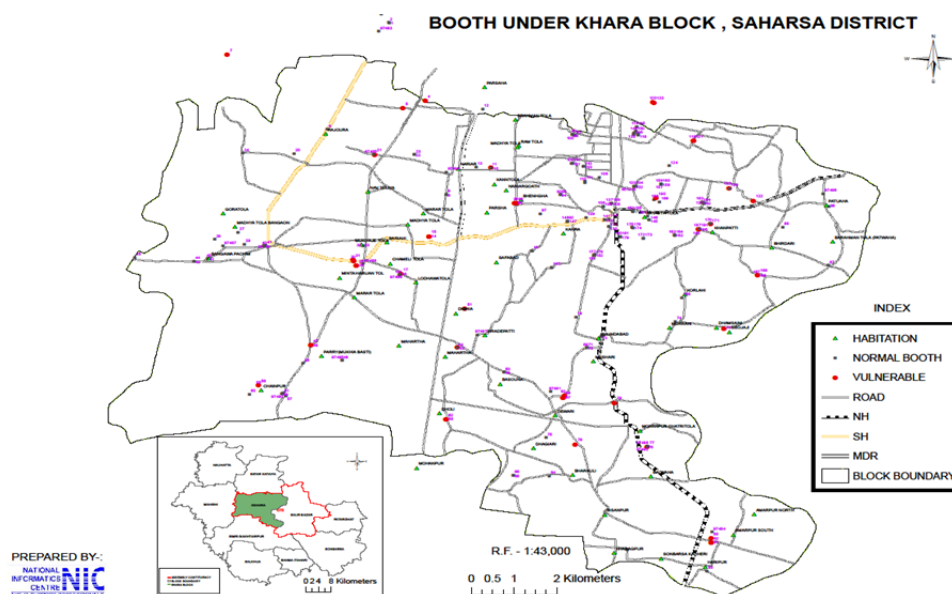

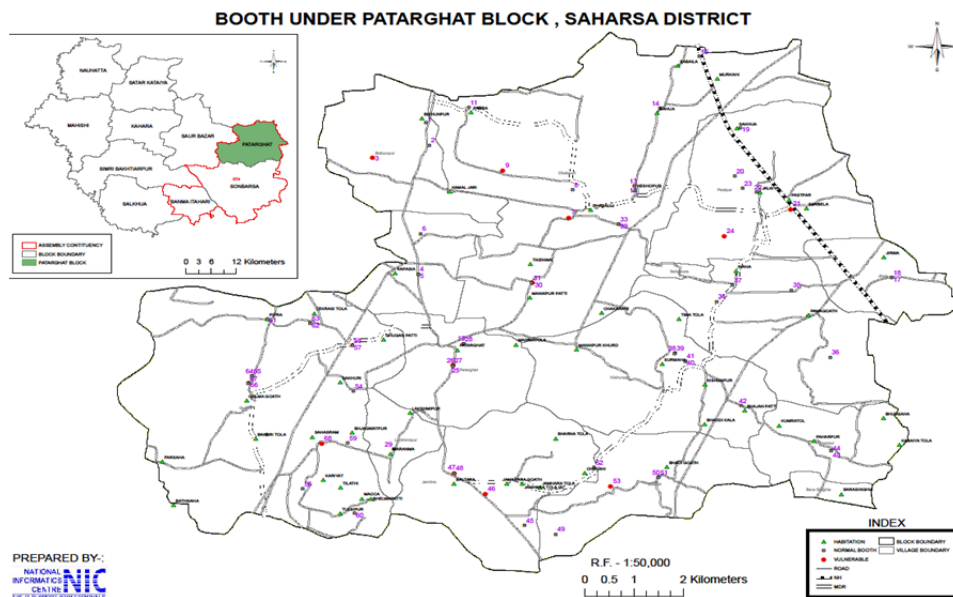

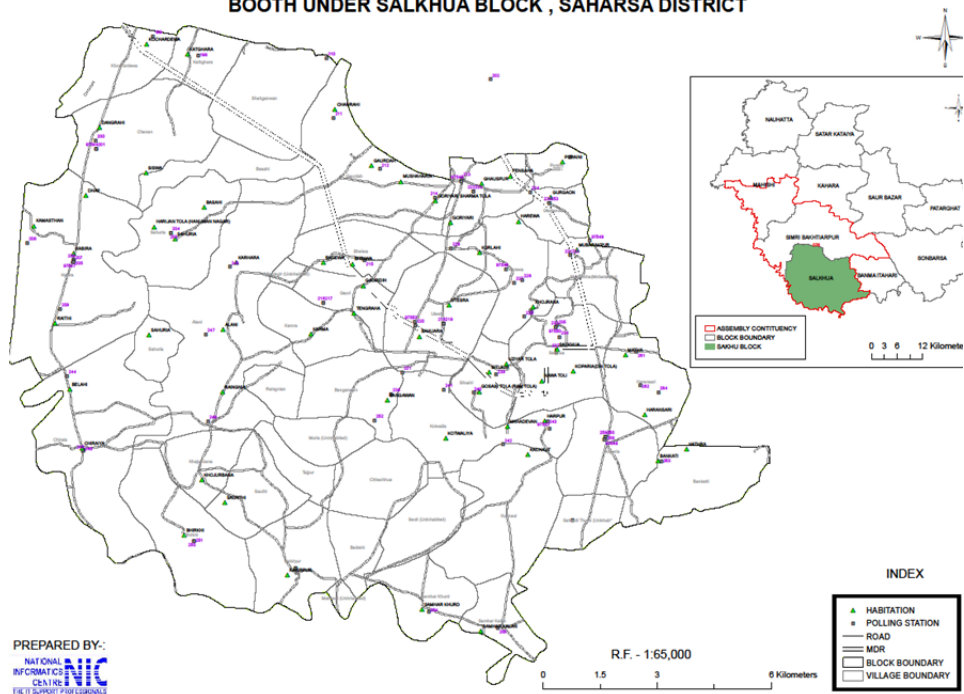

**3.14. Land Utilization Pattern**

About 61.18 % of the newly organized State is under cultivation as per the figures available for the year 2002-03. The percentage of fallow land in the same year is 6.75 %. The corresponding figure for undivided Bihar prior to bifurcation was 42.77 and 16.02 % respectively. Consequent upon bifurcation of the State, forest area has dwindled to a meager 6.65 % from 17.01 %. The forest coverage, thus compares very unfavorably with the national average which stands at around 26 %. The Gross and net sown area

in the State is 80.26 lakh ha and 56.38 lakh ha. respectively. The intensity of cropping is 142%

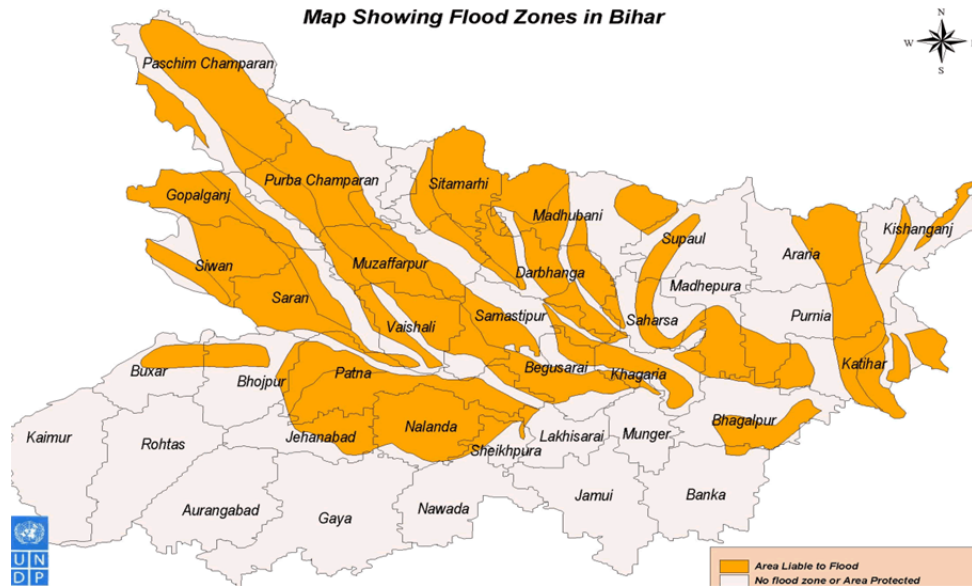
### **3.15. Distribution of Operational Holdings**

As 77 percent of the states' main workforce is employed in the agricultural sector, the average size of operational holdings in Bihar is only 0.75 hectare as against the national average of 1.41 hectare (Govt. of India, 2005). The share of marginal holdings having less than 1 hectare each are as much as 82.9 percent (Annexure II). In addition, marginal and smallholdings account for about 59.8 percent of the total operated area.

### **3.16. Floods and Droughts**

Every year, Bihar faces the vagaries of flood and water logging. Total flood prone area of the State is 68.80 lakh hectares which is 73.06 percent of its total geographical area and 17.2 per cent of the total flood prone area in the country. A substantial proportion of the total cropped area (nearly 41 per cent) gets frequently affected by floods.

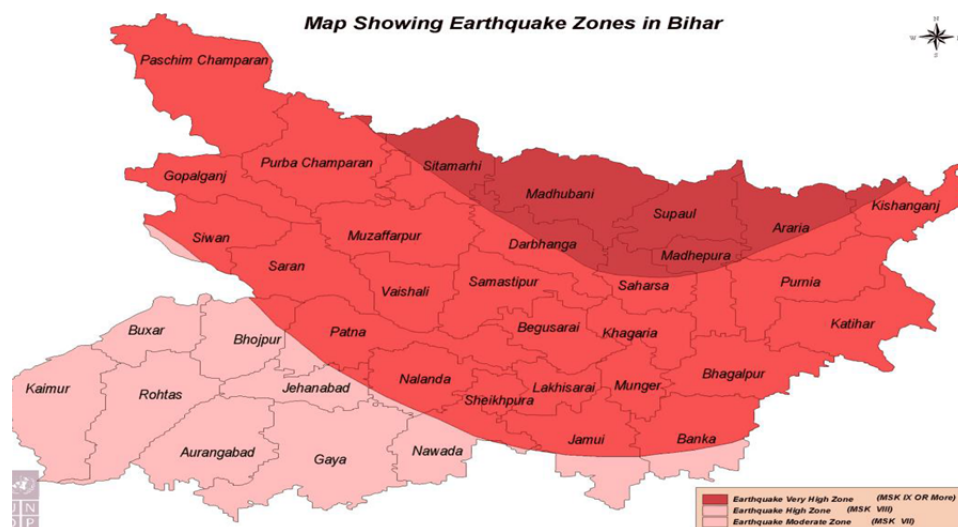


Flood situation is most severe in the northern plains of Bihar. This is because almost all the major rivers in the State enter into Bihar from Nepal in this region. Bed slope of these rivers is very sharp in Nepal and they usually enter the State on plain lands. Because of sudden drop in bed slope, silt brought by the flow of these rivers gets deposited at their base and causes recurring floods.

### 3.17 Earthquake

According to Global Seismic Hazard Assessment Program (GSHAP) data, the state of Bihar lies in a region with moderate to low to high seismic hazard. As per the 2002 Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) map, this state also falls in Zones III, IV & V. Historically, this region has experienced earthquake in the M 5.0-7.0 range.

**Zone-II, North East Alluvial Plains**

This zone comprises the districts of Purnea, Katihar, Saharsa, Supaul, Arariya, Kishanganj, Madhepura and Khagaria covers 11.96% (20797.4 km<sup>2</sup>) of the total geographical area of Bihar. The average annual rainfall in Zone II is 1382.2 mm.<sup>3</sup>

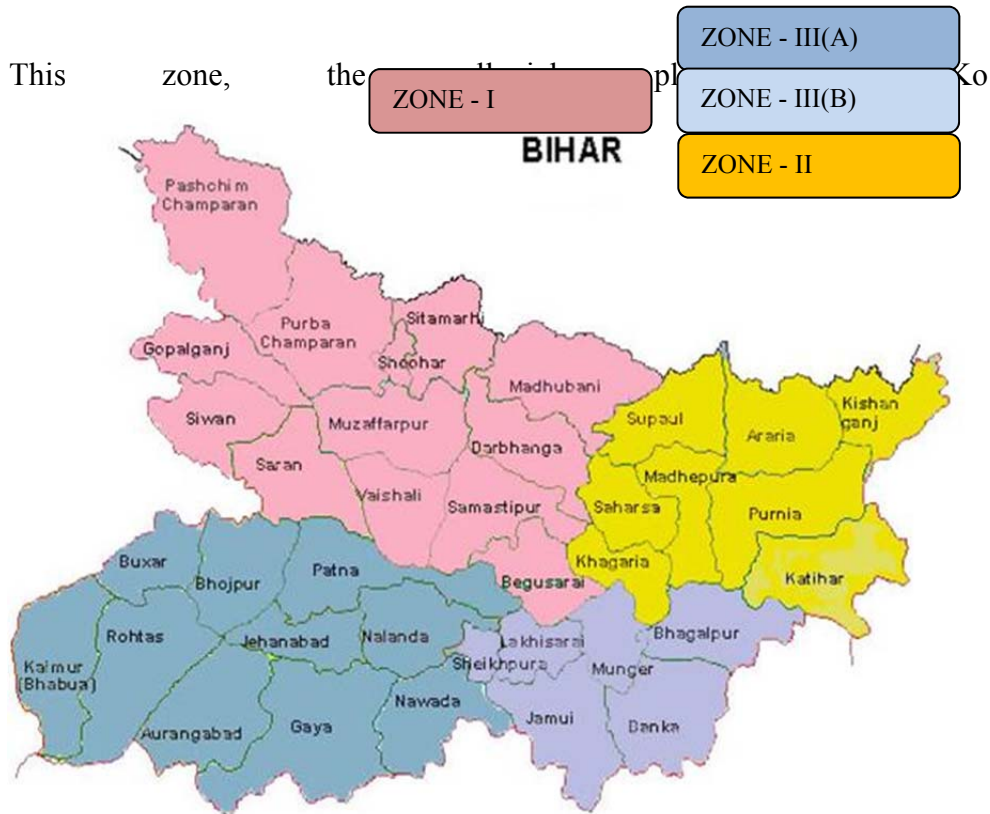
